

## Overview

Active Data Calendar can be configured to match existing website designs seamlessly by incorporating existing website graphic elements. When visitors click on the new Calendar they want to be assured that they have never left your web site! To achieve this uniform look, the following information is intended to help identify webpage layout/design elements and suggest possible implementations with Active Data Calendar.

## Webpage Width

Webpage width can be defined in two different ways, by pixels or by percentage. A fixed page width (Ex.1) will display at the specified width (ex. 800 pixels). A percentage page width (Ex.2) will expand to the specified percentage of the browser (ex. 100%). Percentage page width is variable depending on the browser size.

Ex.1



(Ex.1) - Webpage at 750 pixels wide. Components within the Calendar configure to fill the width specified. The components will not change size or position because the width is fixed.

Ex.2



(Ex. 2) - Webpage at 100% wide. The browser is maximized to a viewing area of approximately 1000 pixels. Components within the Calendar automatically expand to fill the width. As the browser decreases in size the components will adjust accordingly.

## Alignment, Background Images, and Background Color

A webpage can also be aligned left, center, or right. Background images and colors can be used to fill the remaining space not occupied by webpage content. Background color is a solid color that fills the excess page area (Ex.3). A background image can be used for the same purpose however there are more options as a background image can repeat horizontally, vertically, or both (Ex.4).
